Re: Change in Procedure for making Payments to The F.S.R.A.

The Financial Services Regulatory Authority (F.S.R.A.) is coming to the end of its first Calendar year as a Statutory Body. As a result, Management is in the process of reviewing its procedures.

The following change in the procedure for making payments to the Authority by regulated entities/licensees will take effect on January 01, 2015.

- Payments shall be deposited into the Account of the Accountant General at the Bank of St Lucia Ltd (BOSL).
- All cheques will continue to be made to the order of the Accountant General.
- The deposit slip shall be prepared in triplicate, one copy for BOSL, a copy to be retained by the client/licensee and the third copy shall be remitted to the FSRA on or before the due date for the payment.

The deposit slip shall display clearly;

- The name of the regulated entity/Licensee for which the payment is being made;
- The FSRA invoice number or purpose for which the payment is being made;
- The date and amount of the payment; and
- The cheque number issued if payment is made by cheque.
